

Go Team Formation: Essential Roles

Please read the list below and consider one or two roles that may best describe your gifts. Even if you don't feel you fit in one of these categories, you're *definitely* needed.

Team Leader	Team Leader: Organize and motivate your team to assess and meet needs of partner family. You do NOT need construction experience or skill, just the ability and willingness to lead.
	Needs Assessment Eyes: Observe details when visiting the family; determine the people and stuff needed to do the job; a keen observer, familiar with general home maintenance requirements, (but not necessarily able to execute repairs).
	Needs Assessment Heart: "Connect" with the family members, elicit conversation and communication; a good listener and warm, encouraging heart.
	Handyman: lay experience and skill at home repair and maintenance; not necessarily professional, could assist a professional; may provide some tools.
"	Heavy-Lifter: Need I say more? Able to move heavy items as needed, load and unload furniture, etc.
	Decorator: One who can see the potential in a house, and plan the outcome; should be flexible, able to work on a low budget, and consider the unique needs of the partner family.
Charles Charles	Cook: Plan, prepare and serve food to the Team as needed. Doesn't all have to be homemade. Ensures Team energy is nourished with simple, quick snacks and meals.
A	Seasoned Servant: share experience and wisdom, have watchful eyes and mind; able to give time, take care of errands etc.
	Light Laborer: Able to do light physical work such as painting, planting, work a screwdriver, move lightweight boxes. Do-ers who can be task-focused and "get 'er done."
